A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A COUNTY-WIDE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROTECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, political subdivisions have the power, under Ohio law, to enter into a contract for the purpose of providing mutual aid in other political subdivisions for fire protection and emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston has the opportunity to enter into a county-wide fire protection and emergency medical services protection mutual aid agreement; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston wants to provide its residents, as well as the residents of Fairfield County, with the very best and most efficient fire protection and emergency medical protection services possible, and it believes a county-wide mutual aid agreement will help achieve this goal; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of various political subdivisions in Fairfield County to provide for emergency mutual assistance by the inter-change and use of their fire department/EMS personnel and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:


SECTION 1. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Fairfield County Fire Departments Mutual Aid Agreement, in substantially the same form and content as the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, for the provisions of fire protection and emergency medical service protection.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.


SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to enter into this agreement as soon as possible to help provide the best fire and emergency medical protection services to its residents. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
