AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR

WHEREAS, in order to properly compensate elected officials in the Village and keep up with the wages of officials in neighboring villages, the Village of Thurston desires to increase the salary of the Mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

Section 1: The Village of Thurston hereby increases the salaries of the Mayor. In accordance with ORC §731.13, increases in the salary of the Mayor shall not be effective until the termination of the current term of office; or upon appointment to an unfulfilled term.


Section 2: The new salary shall be as follows:

The Mayor shall be paid \$375 per month; these payments shall be paid entirely from the General Fund and made no later than the 5th day of each month.

Section 3: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.


Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.
