A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION PLAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA requires municipalities who operate water systems to adopt a drinking water source protection plan, and

WHEREAS, a drinking water source protection board is required to be created, and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this plan herein described is considered to be a priority need for the community,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO:


SECTION 1: The Village Mayor is hereby authorized to create a Drinking Water Protection Board made up of the Council of the Village of Thurston, and additional members appointed by the Mayor.

SECTION 2: The attached Drinking Water Source Protection Plan for the Village of Thurston, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.


SECTION 3: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
