AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 2014-8 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2014-8, Council for the Village of Thurston established establishing a monthly water debt service fee; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston has been reviewing the Village's water regulations, including the rates being charged and has determined this fee must be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 2014-8 shall be amended to read as follows:

"Council for the Village of Thurston hereby creates a monthly water Debt Service Fee. All accounts for public water the Thurston Water System invoices shall be invoiced, and pay timely, a monthly Debt Service Fee of Fifteen Dollars and No Cents (\$15.00). The "debt service" portion of the monthly potable water charge will be in addition to all other charges."

- SECTION 2: All other sections and sub-sections of Ordinance 2014-8 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.
- SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.
- SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
- SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Village Council needs to amend these rates immediately in order to continue to meet its obligations and provide potable water to the residents of Thurston. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
