AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO EXECUTE A POLE ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH OHIO POWER COMPANY AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston wishes to enter into a pole attachment agreement with Ohio Power; and

WHEREAS, an agreement must be signed by both the Village and the Ohio Power Company before an agreement can go into effect; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement via a Pole Attachment License Agreement, document attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, with Ohio Power Company to allow the Village to attach holiday decoration to poles owned by the Ohio Power Company.


SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective immediately in order to record the proper entries.


