AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE WALNUT TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES TO PROVIDE D-ICING SALT AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston wishes to enter into a contract agreement with Walnut Township for de-icing salt for the Village of Thurston; and

WHEREAS, an agreement must be accepted by both entities before a contract can go into effect; and

WHEREAS, the agreement must be signed immediately in order to allow for the contracted goods to be obtained;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:


SECTION 1: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement, in substantially the same format and content as the document attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, with the Walnut Township Trustees to provide de-icing salt for the Village of Thurston.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.

**CONTRACT BETWEEN
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF WALNUT TOWNSHIP
AND THE VILLAGE Thurston TO PROVIDE DE-ICING SALT: 2016-17**

The board of trustees of Walnut Township does hereby agree to furnish, subject to reasonable availability to the township and the needs of Walnut Township, such amount of salt as may be requested from time to time by the Village of Thurston, a political sub-division of the state of Ohio, upon such terms and conditions as legislative authority of the Village of Thurston and the Board of Trustees.

The parties hereto agree that Walnut Township shall in no way be liable for any failure to furnish salt for the Village of Thurston.

The Village of Thurston will be billed monthly for the Township's cost of the salt that is provided from Walnut Township.


The Village of Thurston assumes all liability for any damage that might occur during the use of salt on the streets in the Village of Thurston.

The unit of measure in determining salt purchase will be one "level scoop" from the Township's front – end loader. For calculation purposes, each "level scoop" weighs 3 tons as determined by the Township.

Dear Mayor Boring:

Please find attached proposed contract for supplying de-icing salt to the Village 2016 – 17 winter season.

For costing purposes:

- We now have 700 tons in storage now, purchase price \$73.19/ton
- After 1/1/2016 we must purchase 500 tons at \$47.23/ton and take up to 110% of that amount at the same price. Anything that exceeds 110% must be purchased at the market price.
- We continue our past practice of not charging salt storage or loading fees.

The cost of salt will be billed as salt is removed from the barn, starting with the 700 tons on – hand followed by the new contract cost of \$42.73
