AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE CLERK-TREASURER, ESTABLISHING ACCOUNTING CODES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to compensate the Clerk-Treasurer for additional responsibilities given to that position by adding Fire Department payroll duties, the Village of Thurston desires to increase the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer, and compensate from the Fire Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to record the appropriate entries into its financial records under the appropriate accounts; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

Section 1: The Village of Thurston hereby increases the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 2: The new salary shall be as follows:

- (a) The Clerk-Treasurer shall be paid \$675 per month; these payments shall be paid from the following funds:
- a. General Fund \$240;
 - b. Street Fund \$240;
 - c. Water Fund \$120;
 - d. Fire Fund \$75

Section 3: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 4: The following account codes are to be created in the Village accounting system to be used for recording expenditures related to clerk-treasurer salary:

Expense Account:

2901-725-121-0000 (Fire Fund – Clerk-Treasurer)

Section 5: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective immediately in order to record the proper entries.
