AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ACCOUNTING CODES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to provide a small annual token of appreciation to Village employees in the form of a holiday dinner; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to record such expenses into its financial records under the appropriate accounts; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

Section 1: The Village of Thurston hereby approves an annual expense for an employee recognition dinner of \$1,200.

Section 2: The following account codes are to be created in the Village accounting system to be used for recording expenditures related to such events:

Expense Account:

1000-710-490-0013 (Other Supplies and Materials/Holiday/Emp Recognition Event)


