A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE RATE OF PAY FOR THE VILLAGE SECRETARY

WHEREAS, R.C. 731.13 provides the legislative authority shall fix the compensation and bonds of all officers, clerks, and employees of the Village, except as otherwise provided by law; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston now wants to increase the Village Secretary's pay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: The rate of pay for the Village Secretary shall increase \$0.50/hr., from \$10.00/hr. to \$10.50/hr. All necessary taxes and other applicable deductions shall continue to be taken from this salary. This increase will become effective on April 1, 2017.


SECTION 2: On October 1, 2017, the rate of pay for Village Secretary shall increase an additional \$0.25/hr., from \$10.50/hr. to \$10.75/hr. The rate of pay for the Village Secretary then shall increase every six (6) months thereafter October 1, 2017, until the rate of pay equals \$13.00/hr. Unless otherwise provided by Village Council, the rate of pay for the Village Secretary shall not be more than \$13.00/hr. All necessary taxes and other applicable deductions shall continue to be taken from this salary

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


