## AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE CLERK-TREASURER, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 2016-21 AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to fairly compensate the Clerk-Treasurer for the performance and responsibilities in his role; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to rescind Ordinance 2016-21 since the responsibility of payroll did not revert to the Village from the Township as planned; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to record the appropriate entries into its financial records under the appropriate accounts; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to pass the ordinance on an emergency basis in order to reward the Clerk-Treasurer immediately for his excellent services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,  
THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

**Section 1:** The Village of Thurston hereby increases the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer.

**Section 2:** The new salary shall be as follows:

- (a) Effective October 1, 2017, the Clerk-Treasurer shall be paid \$700 per month; these payments shall be paid from the following funds:
- a. General Fund 40 %
  - b. Street Fund 40 %
  - c. Water Fund 20 %

**Section 3:** The salary of the Clerk-Treasurer shall increase by \$240 per year starting on October 1, 2018, and on that date each year after that; paid proportionately from the funds as listed in Section 2 above.

**Section 4:** All prior Ordinances, including Ordinance 2016-21, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
