A RESOLUTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO TO ADOPT THE 2017 FAIRFIELD COUNTY NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Thurston recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Village of Thurston and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Thurston has prepared a multi hazard mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long term risk to people and property in Village of Thurston from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the Fairfield County 2017 Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Village of Thurston from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the adoption by the Council of the Village of Thurston demonstrates to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2017 Fairfield County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS this legislation must be adopted as an emergency to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village of Thurston;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village of Thurston does hereby wish to participate in the mitigation program as outlined in the County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan as written by the Fairfield Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security and hereby adopts the plan.

SECTION 2: The Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.

SECTION 3: Due to changes in the FEMA policy, this resolution supersedes any previous resolution passed in regards to adoption of this plan.
