AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION FOR FIREFIGHTERS EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston wishes to enter into an agreement with Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for a Safety Intervention for Firefighters Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant; and

WHEREAS, an agreement must be signed by the Village before an agreement/application can go into effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement via an agreement and application for safety intervention grant for firefighters exposure to environmental elements, document attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, with Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the Village of Thurston.



SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
