AN ORDINANCE, FOLLOWING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF VILLAGE CLERK-TREASURER, TO COMBINE THE DUTIES OF VILLAGE CLERK AND VILLAGE TREASURER INTO THE APPOINTED OFFICE OF VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER

Emergency

WHEREAS, a vacancy currently exists in the unexpired term of the elected office of the Village of Thurston Clerk-Treasurer, following the resignation of former Clerk-Treasurer Aaron Reedy which became effective on 5-9-18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 733.262(B) states that when such a vacancy exists, Council for the Village of Thurston may combine the duties of the clerk and the treasurer into the appointed office of the Village Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 733.262(C) requires the newly created position of Village Fiscal Officer to perform the duties provided by law for the village clerk and treasurer and any other duties consistent with the nature of the office that are provided for by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston now wants to take advantage of the current vacancy on the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer and create the new and appointed position of Village Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thurston hereby creates and establishes the appointed office of Village Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 2: The Village Fiscal Officer shall perform all duties provided by law for the clerk and treasurer, previously performed by the Village Clerk-Treasurer, including but not limited to: keeping the books of the Village; exhibiting accurate statements of all moneys received and expended, of all the property owned by the Village and the income derived therefrom, and of all taxes and assessments; attend all meetings of Council and keep a record of its proceedings and of all rules, bylaws, resolutions, and ordinances passed or adopted; attend necessary training programs; and any other duties consistent with the nature of the office as provided for by ordinance approved by Council for the Village of Thurston.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.

SECTION 5: Pursuant to R.C. 733.262(B), the change from Village Clerk-Treasurer to Village Fiscal Officer shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the effective date of this Ordinance, which will be at the earlier time allowed by law.
