AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF AARON REEDY AS VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER, APPROVING HIS RESIDENCE OUTSIDE OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, following a vacancy in the position of Clerk-Treasurer, Council for the Village of Thurston recently created the appointed position of a Village Fiscal Officer position, as allowed by R.C. 733.262(B); and

WHEREAS, according to R.C. 733.262(D), the Village Fiscal Officer shall be appointed by the Mayor, but that appointment does not become effective until it is approved by a majority vote of the Council for the Village of Thurston; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 733.262(D), the Village Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the Village within six months after the appointment takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Fiscal Officer's residence outside of the Village;

WHEREAS, the Mayor for the Village of Thurston appointed Aaron Reedy to serve as the Village Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Aaron Reedy has accepted this appointment as Village Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thurston hereby approves the Mayor's appointment of Aaron Reedy to serve as Village Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 2: Given Aaron Reedy no longer resides in the Village of Thurston, and will not become a resident of the Village within six months after the effective date of his appointment, Council for the Village of Thurston hereby approves Aaron Reedy's residence outside of the Village of Thurston.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.

SECTION 5: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that it needs to appoint someone to perform the duties of Fiscal Officer immediately. Wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
