A RESOLUTION TO HIRE BOB PANGBORN TO WORK AS THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON WATER SYSTEM OPERATOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, rather than continue to rely on the Village of Pleasantville to oversee and operate the Village of Thurston's water treatment plant and utility, Council for the Village of Thurston created the position of Water System Operator; and

WHEREAS, having created this new position, Council for the Village of Thurston would like to hire someone to work as the Village's Water System Operator; and

WHEREAS, Bob Pangborn has the experience, skill, and qualifications to perform the duties and responsibilities of the Village of Thurston Water System Operator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:


SECTION 1: Council for the Village of Thurston hereby hires Bob Pangborn to work as the Water System Operator. His duties, responsibilities, and pay shall be governed by the ordinance creating the Water System Operator position and the job description attached thereto. He will be paid for four (4) hours per day, even (7) days per week. This is an at-will employment relationship.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.

SECTION 4: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that Village Council needs fill this position by July 1, 2018, because the Village of Pleasantville will no longer perform these services. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
