## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

From: Certificate of Available Resources. . . . . \$ 300.00


To: 5101-531-213-0000 (Medicare). . . . . \$ 300.00
