AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston desires to increase appropriations to allow for the recording of payroll-related expenses; and

SECTION 1: The following amendments are hereby made to the 2018 Appropriations Ordinance:


