Ordinance No. 2021-5 Passed April 14, 2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE #6-6-96-2 AND THEREBY INCREASING THE PRICE OF CEMETERY PLOTS FOR THE VILLAGE CEMETERY

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 6-6-96-2, Council for the Village of Thurston established certain regulations governing administration of the Thurston Cemetery by the Thurston Cemetery Board; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance 6-6-96-2 specifically sets forth the price of cemetery plots; and

WHEREAS, over the past twenty-five years, the price of cemetery plots in the Thurston Cemetery has never been amended; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston would like to amend and increase the price of cemetery plots in the Thurston Cemetery in order to stay current with rising costs, and to further ensure the continued and efficient maintenance, operations, and upkeep of the Thurston Cemetery. In order to do so, it must amend Section 2 of Ordinance #6-6-96-2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Ordinance #6-6-96-2, adopted on June 6, 1996, shall be amended to read as follows:

2. The cost of one (1) plot is \$900.00. There is also a \$50.00 perpetual care charge due for upkeep of the cemetery. Total costs for cemetery plots are to be collected by the Mayor or Fiscal Officer and must be paid before the day of burial. If the Mayor or Fiscal Officer cannot be reached for payment, the check or money order may be deposited in the drop box at the Village municipal building at 2215 Main Street Thurston, Ohio 43157.

SECTION 2: All other sections and sub-sections of Ordinance #6-6-96-2 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
