AN ORDINANCE TO CONTRACT WITH THE VILLAGE OF BALTIMORE TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES, ADOPT BALTIMORE ORDINANCES FOR TRAFFIC AND CRIMINAL OFFENSES, AND TO COLLECT FINE AND FEES ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO

WHEREAS the Village of Thurston has contracted with the Village of Baltimore Police Department for police services within the Village of Thurston; and

WHEREAS any traffic or criminal citations issued by Village of Baltimore Police Department inside the territorial limits of the Village of Thurston are currently filed in the Fairfield County Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS the Village of Baltimore operates a Mayor's Court for any traffic or criminal citations issued pursuant to Village of Baltimore Codified Ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE FOURTHS' (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The Village of Thurston hereby adopts Baltimore Codified Ordinances for traffic and criminal offenses, as currently codified and as may be amended from time to time, as if their own, copies of which attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: This Council adopts the Baltimore Codified Ordinances with the express intent of eligible traffic or criminal citations issued by Baltimore Police Department within the Village of Thurston be filed in Baltimore's Mayor Court.
