AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF HIGH STREET FOR A SPECIAL EVENT ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2021, IN THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a special event concert, the Farm Tour 2021 featuring country artist Luke Bryan, is scheduled to take place on Friday, September 17, 2021 at 8855 Millersport Road, Baltimore, Ohio 43105; and

WHEREAS, temporary large-lot concert parking will be located just west of High Street and north of Fifth Street, near the Thurston Walnut Fire Department at 8474 High Street, Thurston, Ohio 43157; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston expects high attendance at the nearby concert and therefore has carefully examined the flow of traffic, on-street and/or street right-of-way motor vehicle parking availability on the east side of High Street, and the Village's need to temporarily restrict such parking during the upcoming concert; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 715.22 grants the Village of Thurston the general power to regulate the use of the streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston, in order to facilitate this special event temporary parking, assist with traffic flow, provide safer streets, free movement, access of emergency vehicles, and better lines of sight during the upcoming concert, believes it is necessary to temporarily prohibit parking on the east side of High Street in the Village of Thurston on Friday, September 17, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: No person shall permit or cause the stopping, standing, or parking of a motor vehicle on the east side of High Street from Main Street north to the Thurston Walnut Fire Department located at 8474 High Street, Thurston, Ohio 43157, or within the High Street right-of-way, in the Village of Thurston, Ohio on Friday, September 17, 2021 between 12:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m., except as when necessary to avoid a conflict with other traffic or while obeying the lawful directions/orders of a police officer or a traffic control device.

SECTION 2: Council for the Village of Thurston hereby authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, to purchase and install, or have installed, temporary "No Parking" signs at, near, and along High Street displaying the temporary parking restrictions set forth in Section 1.

SECTION 3: Whoever violates Section 1 is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.

SECTION 6: Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality and the further reason that the Village needs to authorize these temporary parking restrictions on High Street as soon as possible so that appropriate signage may be prepared in light of the fast-approaching concert. 


Ordinance receives the required affirmative votes of Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
