AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW FUND, NEW ACCOUNTING CODES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Village of Thurston desires to accept money from the federal government under the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS the Village of Thurston needs to record the appropriate entries into its financial records under the appropriate funds and accounts; and

WHEREAS the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: Fund 2151 (Local Fiscal Recovery Fund) is to be created in the Village accounting system to be used for recording revenue and expenditures related to such.

SECTION 2: The following account codes are to be created in the Village accounting system to be used for recording receipts related to such:


Revenue Accounts:
2151-411-0000 (Federal Restricted)

SECTION 3: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective immediately in order to record the proper entries.
