AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE SALARY OF THE FISCAL OFFICER POSITION

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston desires to increase the salary for the position of the Fiscal Officer in the Village that is currently filled by Aaron Reedy; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston has reviewed salaries paid by other similar-sized villages in the State of Ohio and found the current position's salary lower; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston has reviewed the salary history for the position (and that of Clerk/Treasurer) which Aaron Reedy has filled, and found that the salary has gone up and down arbitrarily over the last twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to fairly compensate the Fiscal Officer for the performance and responsibilities in this role, which have increased exponentially over the last twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to record the appropriate entries into its financial records under the appropriate accounts; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to pass the ordinance on an emergency basis in order to pay the Fiscal Officer immediately for his services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

Section 1: The salary for the Fiscal Officer shall be as follows:

- (a) Effective as earliest possible allowable by law, the Fiscal Officer shall be paid \$1,000 per month; these payments shall be paid from the following funds:
- a. General Fund 40 %
 - b. Street Fund 40 %
 - c. Water Fund 20 %

Section 2: The salary of the Fiscal Officer shall increase by 2.5% (two and a half percent) per year starting on the annual anniversary date of such salary becoming effective, and on that date each year after that; paid proportionately from the funds as listed in Section 2 above.

Section 3: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
