Ordinance No. 2021-23 Passed September 8, 2021

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston desires to increase appropriations to allow for the purchase and installation of a phone system within the Village Municipal Building that will provide better service and better communications to the public and Village residents it serves, especially during these times of financial uncertainty and of social health upheaval caused by the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston wishes to be better prepared to handle growing communication needs, remote telephony messaging and set itself up to engage residents and utility customers in a timely manner for requests and emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston desires to continue in building public trust through strong communication strategies across all digital channels and demonstrating a commitment in the use of digital technologies to strengthen pandemic management, and future preparedness for COVID-19 and other infectious diseases; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to record the appropriate entries into its financial records under the appropriate accounts; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to purchase the equipment and record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: The following amendments are hereby made to the 2021 Appropriations Ordinance:

From: Certificate of Available Resources. \$ 5,000.00
To: 2151-790-410-0000 (Office Supplies and Materials) \$ 5,000.00

SECTION 2: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective immediately in order to record the proper entries.
