AN INTERIM APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 (JANUARY 1, 2022 TO MARCH 31, 2022) AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this resolution shall be passed as an emergency since the resolution needs to be in place immediately;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO,
THREE FOURTH'S (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION 1: That in order to provide for the payment of the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Thurston during the first quarter of the fiscal year 2022, ending on March 31, 2022, the following sums be and are hereby appropriated as follows:

SECTION 2: That the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to draw upon the treasury of the Village of Thurston for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve the same, or by an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make expenditures, provided that no warrants by the authority of and in accordance with law or Ordinance and Resolution.

SECTION 3: For the reason noted in the preamble, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. Therefore, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage by Council.
