## AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A MUSEUM FUND AND AUTHORIZE ACCOUNT CODES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston wishes to accept the ownership, control, and operations of the Thurston Museum as well as its inventory and funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston needs to create an appropriate fund and authorize the appropriate account codes to be used for museum revenue and expenses; and

WHEREAS, the money received, including donations, on behalf of the Museum is restricted and committed to use only for Museum-related expenses; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to record the necessary transactions in a timely fashion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, THREE FOURTHS' (3/4'S) OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

**SECTION 1:** The following fund is to be created for Museum financial reporting:

2902 – Museum Fund

**SECTION 2:** The following financial account codes are to be created for financial reporting:


Revenue:

2902-529-0000 (Other – Cultural & Recreational Programs)  
2902-931-0000 (Transfers In)

Expenditures:

2902-330-420-0000 (Operating Supplies and Materials)  
2902-330-431-0000 (Repairs & Maintenance of Buildings & Land)


**SECTION 3:** For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio.
