A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO TO APPLY AND THE RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP (RCAP) TO SUBMIT THE ELECTRONIC APPLICATION FOR CDBG RESIDENTIAL PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT (RPIG) FINANCING TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR THE WALNUT CREEK SEWER DISTRICT PROJECT AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston is a part of the Walnut Creek Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, the Walnut Creek Sewer District is under EPA violations for wastewater discharges into Little Walnut Creek, a part of the Walnut Creek watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston and the Walnut Creek Sewer District do not have the funds available within their respective budgets to finance the project, therefore the Village of Thurston and the Walnut Creek Sewer District will complete the project and seek financing from outside programs; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has recommended the passage of this Resolution as a measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and property.

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to apply for the funds necessary for the project in a timely manner;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Village Council of Thurston, Ohio:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Grant (RPIG) financing necessary to finance a portion of the project.


Section 2: The Rural Community Assistance Partnership (RCAP) is hereby authorized to submit the electronic application to the Ohio Department of Development for CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Grant (RPIG) financing.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon final passage.

Section 4: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
