Ordinance No. 2022-17 Passed July 13, 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 2021-21, AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 2021-27, SETTING THE SOURCE OF FUNDING FOR THE VILLAGE SECRETARY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with Ordinances 2021-21 and 2021-27, Council for the Village of Thurston established source of funding for paid employee positions within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Thurston wishes to change the source of funding for some positions within the Village in order to pay a new Water System Operator out of the Water Fund, and these changes will help afford a higher rate for the new operator out of the that fund;

WHEREAS, Council wishes to pass the ordinance on an emergency basis in order to pay the employees from the appropriate funds and allow for the immediate hiring of a Water System Operator;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 2021-21 shall be amended to read as follows:

The salary for the Fiscal Officer shall be as follows:

- (a) Effective as earliest possible allowable by law, the Fiscal Officer shall be paid \$1,000 per month; these payments shall be paid from the following funds:
 - a. General Fund 60 %
 - b. Street Fund 40 %

SECTION 2: Section 3 or Ordinance 2021-27 shall be amended to read as follows:

As Village Administrator, Carly Sparrow shall be paid \$330 bi-weekly; these payments shall be paid from the following funds:

- a. General Fund 75 %
- b. Street Fund 25 %

SECTION 3: The salary for the Village Secretary shall be funded as follows:

- a. General Fund 100 %

SECTION 4: All other sections and sub-sections of Ordinances 2021-21 and 2021-27 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 6: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.




