Resolution No. 2022-29 Passed December 14, 2022

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FEDERALLY APPROVED 2023 FAIRFIELD COUNTY NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Thurston recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Village of Thurston; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Thurston has prepared a multi hazard mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long term risk to people and property in the Village of Thurston from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the 2023 Fairfield County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Village of Thurston from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the adoption by the Council of the Village of Thurston demonstrates to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2023 Fairfield County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS this legislation must be adopted as an emergency to protect the safety and well-being of the residents of the Village of Thurston;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO, THAT;

SECTION 1: In accordance with 44 CFR Part 201, the Council of the Village of Thurston adopts the Federally approved 2023 Fairfield County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.

SECTION 2: The Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this municipality. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the required affirmative votes of Council, it shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by Council.

SECTION 3: This resolution supersedes any previous resolution passed in regards to adoption of this plan.


