Ordinance No. 2022-8 Passed April 13, 2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS H (TEMPORARY USERS/BULK SALES), OF ORDINANCE 2021-18 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2021-18, Council for the Village of Thurston established regulations governing residential water customers and their accounts; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Thurston has been reviewing the Village's water regulations, including the rates being charged and has determined they can decrease Temporary User/Bulk Water rates based on actual water production costs and in order to stay competitive in the vicinity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 1(H) of Ordinance 2021-18 shall be amended to read as follows:

H. Temporary Users/Bulk Sales: Water may be purchased on a temporary basis through a bulk water sale. All sales of bulk water shall be at the rate of \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons. All bulk water sales will be metered and made at the following hydrant locations:

- ❖ In the alley behind 2322 Main Street near 8036 Oak Street
- ❖ 2215 Main Street
- ❖ 8061 Broad Street

The Village will purchase and supply the meter on a monthly basis that must be used when purchasing bulk water. All bulk water sales shall be at the rate of \$10.00 per 1,000 gallons. However, even if the meter holder purchases less than 20,000 gallons in any month, he/she will pay \$200.00/month to have use of the meter. Also, the \$15 debt-service fee will be assessed monthly per account.

The number of meters, which are supplied by the Village on a monthly basis, will be limited at the sole discretion of the Village. The Village, at its sole discretion, can ask a meter holder to return a meter. Customers must return a meter immediately upon request.

Customers must provide their own means and manner to haul the bulk water. An important thing to remember is that a gallon of water weighs approximately 8.30 lbs. This means 500 gallons of water weighs 4,150 lbs., or more than two tons. Please remember to consider the weight of the water you will be hauling.

SECTION 2: All other sections and sub-sections of Ordinance 2021-18 shall remain unchanged, in effect, and enforceable.


SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.
