June 2, 2010 – Special Meeting

Mary said the purpose of this meeting was to have a public meeting regarding the Neighborhood Revitalization grant through CDBG for community improvements.

There were 4 residents present at this meeting.

Holly Mattie was present from Fairfield County Regional Planning. She apologized that James Mako was not available to make the meeting. Holly went over the proposed projects for this CDBG project. She discussed the survey responses and how they analyzed the input from the last special meeting on the same project.

Holly shared 4 possible scenarios for prioritizing the possible projects for this grant. She hung them from poster paper on the wall for all to see. Council discussed the different scenarios. Council agreed on Scenario One;

- Water Meter Replacement
- Storm Sewer Improvements
- New Street Signs
- New Cemetery Fence
- Sidewalk Improvements

Everyone feels this will impact the community in the maximum extent.

Donna Foxmore was present from Fairfield County Community Action. She discussed how they had targeted the CHIP (Community Housing Improvement Program) program to go along with the Neighborhood Revitalization Grant. The two projects would work well together; one for the public needs, the other for private needs.

She said we will find out in September if Thurston residents are eligible for this program. Donna also discussed energy programs that are available for residents, and passed out some information about Community Action and the services it provides.
