The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the CGBG Neighborhood Revitalization Grant. James Mako was present from Fairfield County Regional Planning. James shared the status of the project with the council and the audience. There were 9 residents present. James also shared the budget tables on the projects.

Audience discussed drainage issues on the east side of the tracks along state route 256. Residents would like Council to consider fixing the problem if there is money available. A couple of residents repeated how important the drainage issue was, and apologized for “beating a dead horse.”

James also discussed the “CHIP” program with the residents. He said he had the CDBG grant application 95% completed. The project timeline will take two years.

The deserted property next to the Municipal Building was also discussed. Residents said it needs to be torn down because it’s a nuisance.

James thanked everyone for coming out. Mary thanked James for the hard work he has put into this project for the Village.
