

Village of Thurston
Council Meeting Minutes
*** SPECIAL MEETING ***
April 27, 2017

Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm by Mayor Mary Boring. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the live water line issue at the Circle K property at St Rt. 37 & 256.

Bob Pangborn, Village water operator, and Wes from WF Lewis Construction were also present.

Mary said there's an issue at the Circle K property at St. Rt. 37 & 256. A few years ago, they had abandoned their tap because they went on Baltimore water. They were doing some work out there the other day and found that our line that goes into the building was still live. Bob said he went out and they were not able to locate where the actual shut-off/meter pit is. They believe it's been paved over, and we no longer have access.

After some discussion, Bob Pangborn said we know where the main is, so shut it off at the corp stop and cap it. But we'll have to dig on the west edge of their driveway, displacing some asphalt. The previous owner said he remembers widening the approach to Rt 256, but doesn't remember which side the curb box was on. The curb box should NEVER be covered. The Village always has to have access to it. This needs to be fixed right away, there's a slow leak there now in the building. We'll need to get Bob Price or Sureshot to do this work.

Garry made a motion to hire a contractor to dig and cut off the service at the corp stop at the main and then repair/patch whatever we tore up. Robert seconded the motion. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Garry made a motion to adjourn. Robert second. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried. Time is 3:20 p.m.
