Council Meeting Minutes
May 12, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor Mary Boring. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

2022 Budget Hearing – Aaron presented the 2022 Budget to Council. Council reviewed. Scott made a motion to approve the 2022 Budget Council. Garry seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Visitors: Robert Amiet was present from 2161 Main St. He said he checked out in the back of the municipal property where there was alleged dumping. He didn't see anything. He said it wouldn't be a bad idea if brush was dumped there to build up the swampy area.

Garry made a motion to approve the April meeting minutes. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried. Robert made a motion to approve the April financial statement. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Garry made a motion to waive the 3-reading rule and declare an emergency for Resolution 2021-09 - A Resolution Authorizing and Directing the Mayor to Execute A Temporary Easement and A Permanent Easement for The Use and Benefit of The Ohio Department of Transportation and Declaring an Emergency. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Robert made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-09 - A Resolution Authorizing and Directing the Mayor to Execute A Temporary Easement and A Permanent Easement for The Use and Benefit of The Ohio Department of Transportation and Declaring an Emergency. Garry seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Garry made a motion to waive the 3-reading rule and declare an emergency for Ordinance 2021-10 - An Ordinance Again Amending Section 4 Of Ordinance 2019-3 And Thereby Adding A Minimum Monthly Charge for Bulk Water Sales, Adding Two Locations at Which Bulk Water Can Be Purchased, and Making Clear Such Purchase Opportunities are Limited and Declaring an Emergency. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Robert made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2021-10 - An Ordinance Again Amending Section 4 Of Ordinance 2019-3 And Thereby Adding A Minimum Monthly Charge for Bulk Water Sales, Adding Two Locations at Which Bulk Water Can Be Purchased, and Making Clear Such Purchase Opportunities are Limited and Declaring an Emergency. Garry seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

Business from the Fire Chief – Chief Bob Price was present. He didn't have anything to bring to Council, just his report.

Business from the Safety Committee – No Business.

Business from the Service Committee – No Business.

Business from the Finance Committee – Didn't meet.

Business from the Regional Planning Representative – Robert said there was nothing that concerned the Village.

Old Business – none

New Business – Garry made a motion to declare two 5-year old computers as excess inventory. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried. Aaron said he would find a place to donate them.

Garry made a motion to appoint Scott Whited as the Village Representative to serve on the Walnut Twp Safety Advisory Committee. Robert seconded. Roll call vote: all YES, with Scott abstaining. Motion carried.

Scott made a motion to stop mowing the vacated property on Elm St. since it's now owned by the county land bank. Garry seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.

JoAnn made a motion to adjourn at 7:15 pm. Scott seconded. Roll call vote: all YES. Motion carried.
