

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2009-14

Passed July 8, 2009

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AND ASSESS AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE WHEN THE VILLAGE CERTIFIES COSTS, EXPENSES, UNPAID BILLINGS, AND OTHER AMOUNTS TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on occasion and as allowed by law, the Village of Thurston must certify to the County Auditor costs, expenses, unpaid billings, and other amounts;

WHEREAS, the Village of Thurston incurs certain costs and expenses when it is forced to certify costs, expenses, unpaid billings, and other amounts to the County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, in order to promote sound fiscal policies and better manage its limited resources, the Village of Thurston needs to charge an administrative fee for certifying amounts to the County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance will need to be passed on an emergency basis in order to collect necessary funds badly needed to keep the Village in operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THURSTON, OHIO THAT:


Section 1: Whenever, as allowed under Village Ordinance, state and/or federal law, or any other rule or regulation, the Village of Thurston certifies to the County Auditor any costs, expenses, unpaid billings, or other amounts to be placed on the tax duplicate as a lien for collection, the Village shall assess the property owner an additional administrative fee of \$50.00. The administrative fee shall be added to the original amount owed by the property owner at the time the lien is reported to and recorded by the County Auditor. The Village may, at its option, proceed with a civil action to recover the costs, expenses, unpaid billings, administrative fee, and/or other amounts.

Section 2: All prior Ordinances, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Village of Thurston which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.


Section 4: For the reasons noted in the preamble, this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Thurston, Ohio. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
